
### **AGO Makes: Summer Edition**



### **SUN PRINTS!**

In this activity, the power of the sun and protective nature of the shade take centre stage! We will play with opposites - light & dark - and make cut-out "sunscreens" to create bold sun prints on construction paper.

#### **Materials:**

- Dark construction paper (fades quickly in the sun)
- Stiff paper (cardstock or use more construction paper)
- Scissors
- Paper clips or clothes pegs
- Tape
- Pencil
- Sunny spot to leave your work for sunscreen printing
- (optional) Objects with interesting shapes that can stay in the sun.



#### Instructions:

- For every print you need two (2) sheets of paper:
  - 1. Dark construction paper this is the bottom paper that will capture the sun print.
  - 2. Stiff paper this is the top paper that you cut to create the sunscreen shape/image.
- On your top/sunscreen paper, draw anything you like we made a circle and then turned it into a sun. We also cut out some clouds.
- Cut out the shape/s.
- Clip or tape your cut-out design to the construction paper.
- Place against the window, sunscreen stencil side facing the sun, or put in a sunny spot on a table
  or patio or pavement make sure it will be safe there for the whole sunny day (or even two) so
  the sun can do its printing by causing the paper to fade.)
- Remove the top paper and your print is done! Look at the power of the sun wow!
- You can use other objects as your sunscreen, including dolls, action figures or other toys!


