






MAKER MATERIALS

- Paper (any kind of paper will work, but a heavier weight paper or cardstock will make your trading card sturdier and feel like a real trading card.
- Scissors
- Ruler (for drawing straight lines)
- Magazines or flyers (Ask an adult first before cutting these!)
- Something for drawing (One of these: pencils, pens, pencil crayons, markers, or even paint)
- Glue (A glue stick works best)



CREATING YOUR CARDS

- Cut your paper into 2½ x 3½ inch rectangles.
 Or trace a card you have at home.
- Look through magazines or flyers for interesting things to cut out. Ask an adult first to make sure it's ok! Animals, body parts and people are all great things to look for.
- Make sure the items you've cut out fit onto your card!
- Get creative! Glue your magazine cut outs onto your cards and start to draw!
- Add some colour! Use what you have at home: pencil crayons, markers, water colour paints will all work!
