



Materials

- Scissors
- Paper and a printer (if you want to print the templates)
- Glue (a glue stick works best)

Let's Get Started

- Print the templates! (or get inspired and create your own!)
- Cut out your images! Cut along the solid lines.
- Fold along any dotted lines. Try folding all sorts of different directions.
- Try and fit your pieces together in fun or experimental ways. Surprise yourself!
- Twist and play with the shape first to make it 3D. When you're happy with the shape glue it!
- Create your own pieces, and keep adding to your playground creation!

Step 2: Twist and glue


Step 3: Attach together









