VINCENT VAN GOGH, *A WOMAN WITH A SPADE, SEEN FROM BEHIND*

Vincent van Gogh, one of the most famous European artists from the 1800s, was influenced by Dutch and French artists who focused on rural life. He immersed himself in the lives of the people who worked on the land and even dressed like them. In this painting, Van Gogh invites us to empathize with the woman's hard labour. The artist has chosen colours that blend the woman with the land.
