Message from the President

The 2015-16 year was one of excitement and change for the Art Gallery of Ontario as we continued to fulfill our mission to bring people together with art, to see, experience and understand the world in new ways.

Throughout the year, 718,200 visitors came through our doors to discover, reflect, play and learn. We brought to Toronto stunning exhibitions that profiled masterpieces from around the world. We celebrated our remarkable collections, introducing visitors to new acquisitions and reintroducing them to old favourites. We invited contemporary artists to add their voices and provide different perspectives to our stories.

We engaged in conversation with our audiences about issues they care about and sought out opportunities for them to share their ideas, both on-site and online, through Instagram, Twitter and Facebook.

In June, we said farewell to Matthew Teitelbaum, who had ably served as our Michael and Sonja Koerner Director, and CEO, for 18 years, and we wished him the best of success as he took on his new position as the Ann and Graham Gund Director of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston. In January, we announced the appointment of Stephan Jost as our new Director and CEO. Stephan joins us from the Honolulu Museum of Art, where he served as Director for five years. I look forward to working with Stephan in 2016-17 as the AGO continues to strengthen and grow.

We are very grateful to the Province of Ontario, the City of Toronto and the Canada Council for the Arts, as well as the many AGO donors and members who generously provide ongoing support to the AGO. This strong public-private sector partnership enables us to make great art accessible to larger and more diverse communities.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

APRIL 2015

- *From the Forest to the Sea: Emily Carr in British Columbia* opens. Organized by the AGO and the Dulwich Picture Gallery in London, England, with the generous collaboration of the National Gallery of Canada, the Vancouver Art Gallery, the Royal BC Museum, BC Archives and the Museum of Anthropology, UBC, this show presents nearly 100 paintings, watercolours and drawings by Canadian artist Emily Carr. British audiences are also introduced to Carr's works, with the exhibition's debut at Dulwich before coming to Toronto.
- The AGO partners with the Michaëlle Jean Foundation, the Environics Institute's Black Experience Project and NIA Centre for the Arts to organize the Scratch & Mix project, which invites youth across the GTA to create works of art on the theme "Empowering the Black Community," inspired by the AGO's exhibition *Jean-Michel Basquiat: Now's The Time*. An exhibition of works by the 11 finalists opens at the AGO as part of a youth solidarity forum that explores issues of social justice.



- *Stephen Andrews POV* opens, the largest solo exhibition of one of Toronto's leading contemporary artists. Organized by the AGO, the show features works on paper, photographs and large-scale paintings charting the artist's exploration of AIDS, surveillance, war, memory and chaos theory.

- Massive Party Hotbed, the Gallery's annual fundraising event, raises \$315,000 for AGO exhibitions and education programs. Curated by multidisciplinary Toronto artist TALWST, the evening features electric performances by cutting-edge artists and never-before-seen art installations.

MAY 2015

- Free After Three drop-in programs for youth are in full swing and include skateboard-building with Oasis Skateboard Factory, breakdancing with Unity Charity, circus art with Social Circus Circle and DIY workshops with artist Paddy Leung. Artmaking sessions include tie-dyeing, terrarium-making, sticker art, temporary tattoos, tote bag painting/printing and more.



- The interactive website AGOLodzGhetto.com is launched with the digital archives of more than 4,000 images from our Henryk Ross Collection of Lodz Ghetto Photographs. The website enables the public to search images by theme, build groupings of photographs, tag images and discuss the collection. A section for teachers and students offers four lesson plans for classroom use, including resources that address modern human rights issues.
- More than 250 high-school students visit as part of the Toronto District School Board's "Expressing Aboriginal Cultures" course. Students take part in a live performance by Kaha:wi Dance Theatre, tour the galleries and participate in artist workshops. The AGO welcomes 37,000 students during the year through school group programs.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

- Passers-by see conservators from the AGO and The Henry Moore Foundation in action with the iconic sculpture *Large Two Forms* on the southwest corner of Dundas and McCaul streets. Restoration work includes replacing and strengthening the metal that has thinned, as well as restoring the original colour and surface texture of the sculpture, so it can be enjoyed for many more years to come.

JUNE 2015

- *Picturing the Americas: Landscape Painting from Tierra del Fuego to the Arctic* opens as the AGO's tribute to the 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games. Developed jointly through an innovative partnership with the Terra Foundation for American Art and the Pinacoteca do Estado de São Paulo, the show brings together more than 100 works of art to present the first-ever pan-American landscape exhibition. Following its debut at the AGO, the exhibition travels to the Crystal Bridges Museum of American Art in Bentonville, Arkansas, and then to the Pinacoteca do Estado de São Paulo.
- The AGO bids farewell to Matthew Teitelbaum, who has served as the Gallery's Michael and Sonja Koerner Director, and CEO, for close to 20 years. Mr. Teitelbaum leaves Toronto to take on the position of the Ann and Graham Gund Director of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston.
- The AGO partners with VIBE Arts to present the BIG BAM BOOM Youth-Led Arts Festival, with interactive art activities and performances by children and youth from across the city.
- AGO chefs serve 800 tamales to a hungry crowd as part of the Stop Night Market, an annual fundraising event that supports anti-hunger and anti-poverty programs at The Stop Community Food Centre.

JULY 2015

- July's First Thursday is guest curated by the indigenous artist collective Ombaasin and explores the contentious issues around colonization and conflict. The night features installations and performances by artists of colour and indigenous artists, including Polaris Music Prize-winning Inuk throat singer Tanya Tagaq, Lori Blondeau, Adrian Stimson, Josh Vettivelu, Travis Shilling and Francisco-Fernando Granados. The popular monthly First Thursdays program engages artists to respond to AGO exhibitions and collections with installations, performances and other public programs.
- The AGO partners with Baycrest Health Sciences, a global leader in innovative geriatric health care, to further the development of the Seniors Arts Engagement Program. Activities include a visit and conversation in gallery spaces followed by artmaking. A complementary Youth Art Ambassador program trains youth to lead discussions about art and artmaking activities at seniors' residences.



- The *AGO Year of Photography* is launched, announcing a 12-month schedule of photography and film exhibitions. First in the series is *Camera Atomica*, which explores the atomic age and its anxieties, with photographs, film and video starting from the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in 1945 to the present. The AGO invites the public to join in an online conversation about these challenging themes at #atomicAGO.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

- The AGO Youth Council takes part in the Teens Convening: Toronto conference, which brings together youth from museums and cultural centres across Southern Ontario to discuss the role that youth councils play within cultural institutions.

AUGUST 2015

- *Liz Magor: Surrender* opens—a solo exhibition of Magor's work to mark her award as the winner of the 2014 Gershon Iskowitz Prize at the AGO. The award is presented annually to an artist who has made an outstanding contribution to the visual arts in Canada.
- Objibwe artist and educator Bonnie Devine works on her installation *Battle for the Woodlands* in gallery space, generously engaging in discussion with visitors as they watch her in action.

- More than 800 campers take part in the AGO Summer Art Camps, with exhibitions to celebrate their many achievements at the end of each session.

SEPTEMBER 2015

- The annual Aimia | AGO Photography Prize exhibition features works by shortlisted artists Dave Jordano (United States), Annette Kelm (Germany), Owen Kydd (Canada) and Hito Steyerl (Germany). Dave Jordano is awarded the prize, selected by public vote. This program also offers scholarships for students working toward a bachelor's degree of fine arts in photography.
- Canadian rock legends Rheostatics reunite at the AGO for the first time in eight years. Musicians Kevin Hearn and Hugh Marsh and filmmakers Jennifer Baichwal and Nicholas de Pencier join the band for a performance of their iconic album *Music Inspired by the Group of Seven*.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

- The AGO presents *Anne Collier*, tracing the American artist's career from 2002 to the present. Organized by the Museum of Contemporary Art, Chicago, this is the first major solo exhibition of Collier's work, encompassing about 40 of her large prints.
- The AGO and the Toronto Symphony Orchestra introduce *The Decades Project: 1900–1999*—a series designed to reveal how artists and musicians expressed both the optimism and scepticism of their time. The first in the series focuses on the decade following 1900, with visitors having the opportunity to listen to Claude Debussy's 1905 work *La mer (The Sea)*, while viewing Armand Guillaumin's 1907 painting of the Mediterranean *Le Trayas: matin, temps gris*.

OCTOBER 2015

- Artist-in-residence Lisa Myers premieres her stop-motion animated work *Each Portion* for Scotiabank Nuit Blanche. Artists-in-residence throughout the year also include the FAG Feminist Art Gallery with Allyson Mitchell and Deirdre Logue; Meera Margaret Singh; and Jérôme Havre.
- The AGO presents *J.M.W. Turner: Painting Set Free*, a stunning and critically acclaimed exhibition that features more than 50 large-scale paintings and watercolours from the final 15 years of Turner's career, on loan from Tate Britain. A social media activation wall is created as part of the exhibition, allowing visitors to make their own digital memento of the show.

- *The Idea of North: The Paintings of Lawren Harris* opens at the Hammer Museum in Los Angeles. Co-organized by the AGO and the Hammer Museum, and guest curated by Steve Martin in collaboration with both museums, this is the first major exhibition of paintings by Harris to be presented in the United States. After its run in Los Angeles, the exhibition travels to the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, and then opens in Toronto on Canada Day—July 1, 2016.
- Art lovers celebrate the launch of Art Toronto 2015 at the Opening Night Preview. This event raises \$466,000 to acquire works of art presented at the fair and to support AGO programming.

NOVEMBER 2015

- AGO Family Sundays return, with weekly interactive, innovative family programs for all ages. A new kids' activity bag is introduced, featuring activities to help families explore our galleries together.

- A spotlight is given to contemporary artists working with divergent media with the exhibition *Many things brought from one climate to another*. This installation marks the AGO debut of several recent acquisitions, including works by Kevin Beasley, Melanie Smith, Paul Chan and Adam David Brown.
- The AGO adds another evening to its public hours and introduces AGO Friday Nights—a program that offers artmaking, performances and various activities designed for adult audiences.
- ShopAGO hosts a book-signing with Michael Snow, one of Canada's most celebrated multidisciplinary contemporary artists, in celebration of his new publication *Sequences—A History of His Art*.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

DECEMBER 2015

- *Drawing, Je t'aime: Selections from the AGO Vaults* presents a treasure trove of more than 100 works on paper that span Renaissance masterworks to contemporary Inuit art. The installation features rarely seen works by a variety of artists, including Jacopo Tintoretto, Edgar Degas, Henri Matisse, Robert Motherwell, Joyce Wieland and Annie Pootoogook.
- *AGO Gives Back*, our staff and volunteer charitable giving program, collects supplies to assist the settlement organization CultureLink in its efforts to facilitate the arrival of Syrian newcomers in Toronto. CultureLink is one of 300 organizations that partner with the AGO to enable individuals to visit through our community access programs.
- A pivotal moment in AGO history is revisited with the installation *A New Look: 1960s and '70s Abstract Painting at the AGO*, featuring works in our collection by Kenneth Campbell Lochhead, Jack Bush, Kenneth Clifton Noland, Morris Louis, Helen Frankenthaler, Gene Davis and Frank Stella. The show pays tribute to the AGO's groundbreaking exhibition *Post-Painterly Abstraction in 1964*, which put Toronto at the forefront of contemporary art.
- To send 2015 out in style, the AGO Youth Council organizes and hosts Last Wednesday, an all-ages dance party at the AGO, on December 30.

- The AGO's famous *Floor Burger* by Claes Oldenburg returns to public view with the installation *SuperReal: Pop Art from the AGO Collection*. Featuring paintings and sculptures by many artists, including Andy Warhol, Jim Dine, Robert Rauschenberg and James Rosenquist, the exhibition profiles the AGO's important collection of pop art objects.
- The AGO proudly announces the appointment of Stephan Jost as the new Michael and Sonja Koerner Director, and CEO. Mr. Jost, who comes from the Honolulu Museum of Art, where he served as director since 2011, begins his tenure at the AGO in April 2016.
- *Choir! Choir! Choir!* performs a special tribute to the late David Bowie, one of the most influential artists of the past 50 years. Choirmasters Nobu Adilman and Daveed Goldman lead a chorus of more than 550 voices to learn one of Bowie's most beloved songs in three-part harmony.
- Visitors are invited to take part in #MuseumSelfie Day by snapping photos of themselves with their favourite work of art at the AGO.

Highlights of the Year

APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

FEBRUARY 2016

- Beijing-based multimedia artist Song Dong makes his Toronto debut with the exhibition *Song Dong's Communal Courtyard*. The AGO invites the local artist community to respond to the work and awards residencies to Basil AlZeri, Peter Chin, Eventual Ashes with Red Slam Collective, Bill bissett and artists of Workman Arts and Annie Wong.
- The popular KGO—Kids' Gallery of Ontario—returns for Family Day with a special day of family artmaking and life-sized games. Offering a full day of drop-in programs, the KGO invites families to experience a variety of exciting hands-on activities.



- The Grange Park revitalization project moves forward with the awarding of the contract to Aldershot Landscape Contractors Limited. The AGO is proud to partner with the local community and the City of Toronto to transform this well-loved greenspace through a design that inspires imagination and meets the needs of this thriving and ever-changing neighbourhood.

MARCH 2016

- Zero Gravity Circus joins the AGO for nine fun-filled days during March Break. Family activities include printmaking, painting and constructing, as well as family tours and yoga.

- *Outsiders: American Photography and Film, 1950s–1980s*, opens, featuring more than 300 works by some of the greatest artists of the period, including Diane Arbus, Garry Winogrand and Danny Lyon. The exhibition presents unforgettable portraits of individuals at odds with society over four turbulent decades.



- The AGO hosts United Way Family Sunday, welcoming families from four United Way neighbourhood hubs across the city. Close to 200 people participate in this event, many visiting the AGO for the first time.
- For Twitter's #MuseumWeek, the AGO invites the public to take part in a global discussion on why museums matter, how they inspire us and what we can all do to keep them vital.

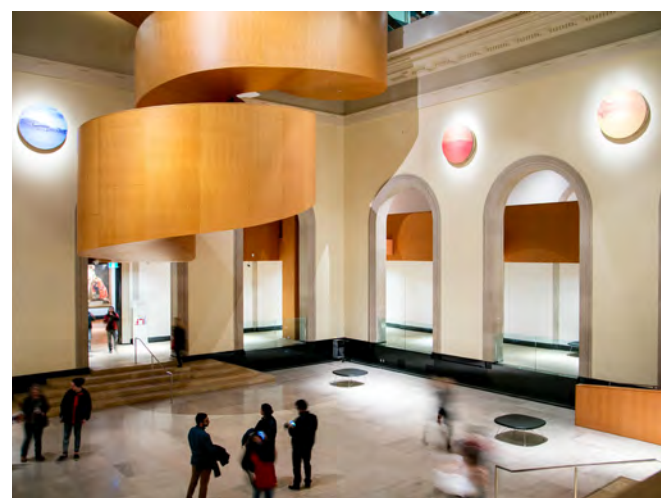

Acquisition Highlights

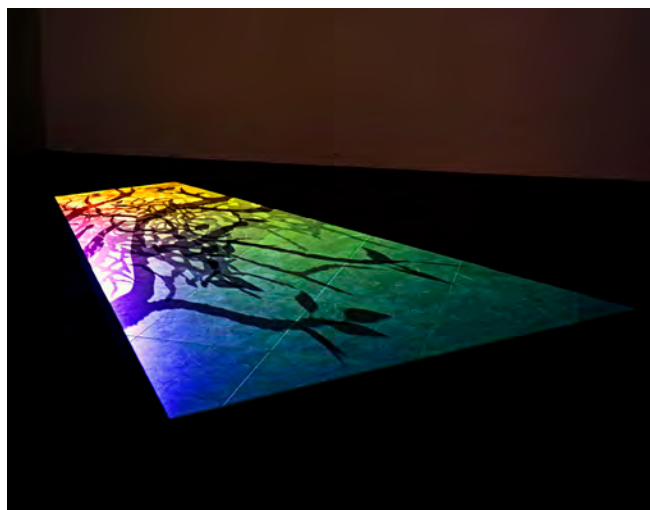
APRIL 1, 2015 – MARCH 31, 2016

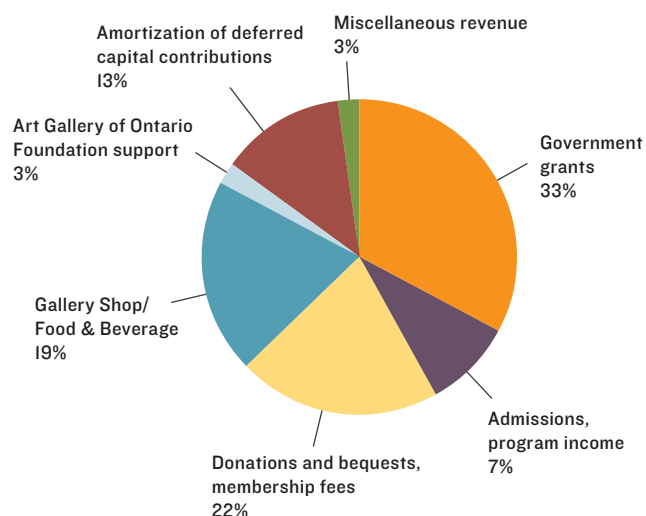

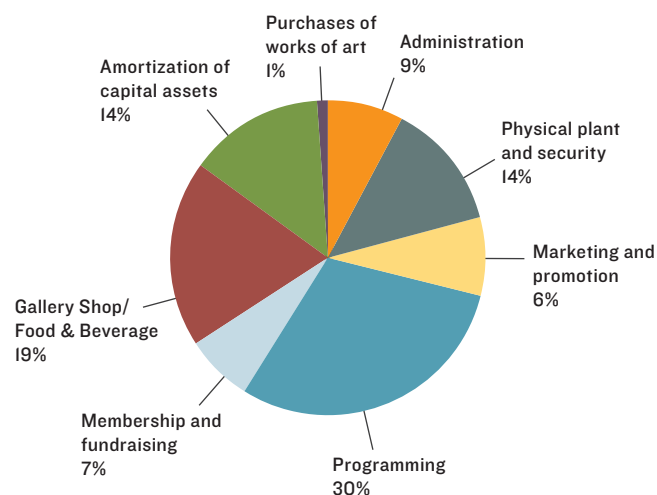

- The above statement of operations provides a summary of the AGO's financial activity for 2015-16. Financial statements for the 2015-16 fiscal year (April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016), audited by Ernst & Young, are available upon request from the Art Gallery of Ontario (Director's Office: 416 979 6613).
- In the 2015-16 fiscal year, the AGO received gifts of works of art with an approximate value of \$24,638,000. This is not reflected in the financial data above, but is included in the AGO's 2015-16 audited financial statements.
- The AGO records capital asset purchases at cost and then amortizes its capital assets over the useful life of the asset. Donations and grants received for the purchase of capital assets are deferred and then amortized based on the useful life of the asset.
- Remeasurement related to pension plan is the difference between actual and expected return on pension plan assets. Additional details can be found in the AGO's 2015-16 audited financial statements.
