


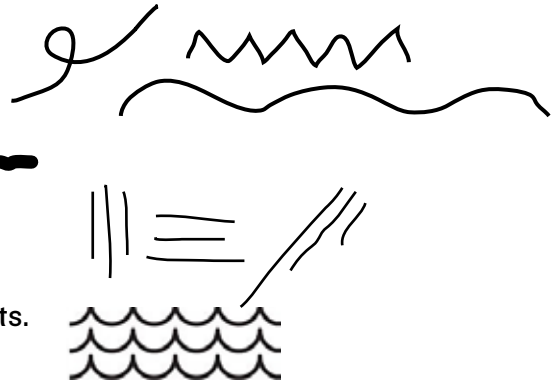

LINES

ART WORDS

Lines are everywhere in art! 

- Lines have **length**. For example, they can be short or long.
- Lines have **paths**. For example, they can be straight or curved, zigzag or wavy.
- Lines have **weight**. They can be thick or thin. 
- Lines have **direction**. They can go up-and-down (vertically), side-to-side (horizontally), or diagonally.
- Lines can make a **pattern**. A pattern is something that repeats.



OBSERVATIONS

What **lines** did you notice in the art? Can you draw the **lines** here? You can use crayons, pencil crayons, markers or any materials you have.

How do these **lines** make you feel when you look at the art? For example, do the **lines** make you feel happy, sad, peaceful, angry, excited? Put your ideas here:
