Class 1: Baroque and Romanticism with a focus on Rembrandt

- · Visit to the AGO collections exploring anatomy and portraiture
- Demo: basic structure of skull and face

Class 2: Contemporary

- · Nature and landscape sketching techniques
- Tone and shade

Class 3: Impressionism and Kazuo Nakamura
