Class 1: Historical Intro into the Birth of Video and Time Based Art

- Laurie Anderson, Bruce Nauman, Nam June Paik, Mona Hatoum, and Michael Snow.
- Write and shoot a simple static shot video work using just yourself and minimal props.
- Intro to Editing and iMovie. Edit sample footage to learn more editing techniques
- · APPS: ProCamera and iMovie

Class 2: Storyboarding and Scripting

- View short artist films and videos. Discuss basic shots and camera angles.
- Story boarding, Shot list, Treatment, Intent and Final Display
- Create a simple script and/or storyboard.
- ProCamera instruction and Camera test
- Shooting and Gathering Assets
- Discuss / demo iphone camera apps.
- Continue discussion of basic shots and camera angles, as well as lighting and external camera effects.
- · Shoot footage based on storyboard to edit next week
- APPS: ProCamera and iMovie

Class 3: Importing, Editing and Exporting

- · What is Installation Art?
- How Editing can be your Video Art. Editing your footage with iMovie on iPad
- Shot footage review.
- Adding music and voice-overs.
- · APPS: iMovie

Class 4: Finish Projects, Premier Your Work, Discussion
