COURSE SYLLABUS

July 8, Week 1: Introduction to the course. Presentation on the History of Street Photography. Discussion: Legal and ethical considerations of Street Photography. Students to explore the AGO perimeter and beyond. Students to work independently and to meet with the instructor individually for feedback. Location: Grange Park

July 15, Week 2: Students to meet at a designated location to take street photographs. Students to work independently and to meet with the instructor individually for feedback. Location: Meet in Kensington Market, Bellevue Park

July 22, Week 3: Students to meet at a designated location to take street photographs. Students to work independently and to meet with the instructor individually for feedback. Location: Meet at Nathan Philips Square. Explore surrounding area.

July 29, Week 4: Students to meet at a designated location to take photographs. Students to work independently and to meet with the instructor individually for feedback. Location: Mutually agreed upon location – students' choice
