Class 1:

Presentation of the beginnings of architectural photography in the nineteenth century. Introduction to the equipment, techniques, terminology, and kinds of architecture to be photographed. Assignment #1, Close to Home

Review of Assignment #1 photographs. Presentation of the evolution of architectural photography in the twentieth century. Assignment #2, Street Level

Class 3:

Review of Assignment #2 photographs. Presentation on architectural landmarks and heritage buildings. Assignment #3, Institutions and Heritage Buildings

Class 4:

Review of Assignment #2. Presentation: Construction, Demolition and Ruins. Assignment 3 Urban Decay.

Class 5:

Review of Assignment #3. Presentation: Vernacular Architecture.
