### Class 1: Introduction to the Course

- Presentation on the History of Street Photography.

- Location: Nathan Philips Square. Explore surrounding area.

### Class 4: Student's Choice

- Students will meet at a designated location to take photographs.
- Students will work independently and meet with the instructor individually for feedback.
- Location: Mutually agreed upon location students' choice

### Class 5: Presentation

• In consultation with instructor, students will present a selection of the best work from the preceding four weeks to present in class
