

COURSE SYLLABUS

Textile Explorations 18+) 4 Week Instructor: Kelley Aitken

Friday, July 5 - 26, 6 - 9 pm

Class 1: Stitch Meditations

 Using a variety of patterned and varied weights of fabric pieces, students will create stitched fabric collages.

Class 2: Printing on Fabric

Cutting a small lino block for repeat printing on fabric, students will learn how to print
on fabric. Students may bring a plain t-shirt or canvas to print on. Plain cotton will be
provided. Creating acetate drawings for solar dye.

Class 3: Washi and Konnyaku

 Students will create sewn collages or tapestry using Japanese paper. Stitching with thread on painted surfaces. (NB: depending on weather this day, we may dive into solar dye)

Class 4: Acid Dye on Silk

Students will have stitched or tied a pattern into their piece of silk. Dye vats will be set
up. If there is sufficient sun for Solar Dye on Cotton we will expose fabric squares to
the sun. Students will bring pressed plant material or lace or other transparent or flat
perforated items or drawings on acetate.



MATERIAL LIST

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Items in **bold** are required for the first class.

- Thimble
- Other materials to be discussed first class. We will do a sun dye project and will ask students to gather and press plant materials, or bring old lace doilies etc.

All material sizes are approximate. Please retain your receipts in case exchanges or returns are needed. On your first day of class, your instructor may recommend additional optional materials. Our Instructors will do their best to accommodate alternative materials whenever possible.
